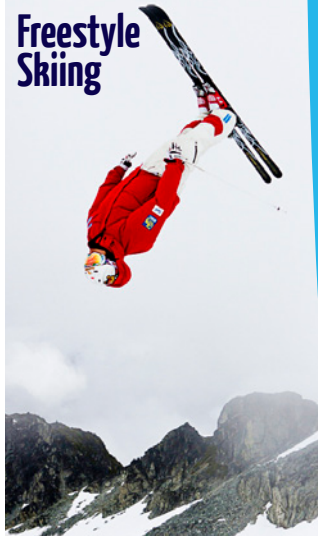


Prince George Judo Club
